IRRIGATION PROJECT UPDATE

Our contractor, IDA, completed **Phase I** - consisting of installing the mainline, valves and connections to all homes - about one month ago. Since then, IDA has been connecting the valves and timing system from the pump to individual homes.

Phase II is now in progress - checking individual homes existing spray heads, replacing broken heads, and correctly directing irrigation spray. This is the most tedious and time consuming component of the project since each of our homes has different irrigation requirements. Sometimes, multiple visits are necessary to adjust properly.

Both Bayport and Pendleton's inner circle of homes will be addressed first, followed by the outer circle.

Please note that the days and times of irrigation are in transition until all homes are completed.

Our thanks to the ongoing efforts of our hardworking **Irrigation Committee**.

Linda Lewis reports that the Masters Association has approved the planting of a hedge on tract H (open area facing Venice East Blvd) along with additional shrubs that will be planted along the bank across from the pond from Pendleton. Also, there will be a designated planting area behind the Bayport homes which the owners will be able to use at their own expense for approved plants.

Kudos to **Linda, board liaison Paul King** and the determined **Landscaping and Grounds Committee members**.

Paul King reminds us that leaf clean up is scheduled for on or about March 29.
