## How Do I Set My Humidistat?

The Weather in Venice is quite nice during the winter months and many of our customers like to boast to their northern friends just how nice blue skies and milder temperatures make them feel compared to the weather in the Northern States.

Unfortunately, some of our homeowners will be leaving in spring to head back up north during the summer.

Many homes in our area have a humidistat attached beside the thermostat on the wall. Setting the humidistat & thermostat can be confusing especially since they are mostly set only twice a year and as a local Air Conditioning company, we are asked quite often by phone on how should they set their Thermostat and Humidistat when leaving and arriving at their Florida residence.

There are multiple ways to wire a humidistat in conjunction with a thermostat; we find a majority are wired in parallel to the thermostat. Since this is the typical configuration, we will explain how most homeowners set these controls when arriving and leaving the home for extended periods.



*When you leave Venice:* Set the Humidistat to 57%, and Thermostat to Cool -  $77^{\circ}$  with Fan to Auto.

When you arrive in Venice: Set the Humidistat to ON, and the Thermostat as you normally would for cool or heat.

Venice Cooling highly recommends having your house checked on a weekly basis to ensure the air conditioner is operating properly and humidity is being maintained at the optimum levels, as an option, it might be good to remotely monitor the temperature and humidity with a Wi-Fi thermostat.

Due to variations in construction and different types of homes, these settings might not be correct for your application.
