The price for removal and sealing will be \$289.00. He will give me a price for both Pendleton and Bayport for sealing the homes. The price might be different for Bayport or not. I will let you all know after he gets on our roof and looks at the soffits and other possible openings. Jo Halstead, 488 Pendleton Place, has been netting her home for two weeks and she says they are still attempting to get into her soffits. Again, Eric's advice is to seal all the homes in order to have the bats move on to somewhere else. The sealing would also keep out rats, raccoons, squirrels, and other destructive creatures. At the very least, a note from Marie should go out to all homeowners to keep their garage doors down all day and evening especially since we are in the removal process at

three homes in the Villas. Also all holes in the cedar siding should be repaired as soon as possible. Those homes that do not have email, should be given a hard copy. Again, this is not a new problem but will be an ongoing issue until all homes are properly sealed. Whether you use Trap Kings or some other Pest Control Company, this needs to be done sooner rather than later.
